

Unfortunately, we're now finding out that news for Lahaina and Kula residents has gotten "even worse."


Shelby Thomson, Founder of Unjected, reported from Maui that the water supply is compromised.

If your water was turned off during the fires / if you are receiving water from Upper Kula - please go to one of the sites with 5gal or smaller jugs and collect free clean water for you and your families to use for drinking, brushing teeth, making ice, and preparing food.


Thomson also reported that the potable water brought in by the government is "making people ill."

"We're also hearing that the potable water being brought in by government officials is making people ill for whatever reason. They're experiencing fevers, chills, and other ailments from drinking this potable water that's been left. So I really urge you guys to please be careful on ingesting this water, and where you're getting it from."

One Facebook user reported getting "super sick" from drinking the government-provided water. "Extremely ill, 104 fevers, and still ill/careful."
